Friday-Saturday, September 6-7 in quiet western Indianapolis, the HOOSIER TRACTION MEET is an annual educational conference recognizing mass transportation, especially electrically powered rail-based systems for urban and regional mobility in the past, present and future. Place-specific presentations typically focus on transit anywhere in the United States or Canada. Discussion of technologies or trends may draw examples from anywhere in North America or beyond.

FORMAT The Meet includes two aspects:

- 1. All can visit the exhibition for free Friday 12NOON-10PM and Saturday 8AM- 4PM EDT. Exhibitors offer items related to mass transport: photos, books, models, timetables and other collectibles.
- 2. The 150-seat theatre-style auditorium hosts 10 different audiovisual presentations, some repeated (see opposite panel). Speakers provide live narration and photos or maps. Media/format may vary.
